SIZES Small (**Medium**, Large, **X-Large**)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Bust 36 (40, 44, 48)"/91.5 (101.5, 112, 122)cm

Length 21 (24, 25, 26)"/53.5 (61, 63.5, 66)cm

MATERIALS

- 10 (13, 15, 17) balls Tahki Yarns **REPLAY** 100% recycled cotton (1.75oz/50g; 92yds/85m) in **color #04 lake**
- One size 6 (4mm) circular needle, 24"/60 cm long **OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Cable needle (cn)
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

GAUGE

22 sts and 28 rows = 4"/10 cm in Cable stitch

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

SPECIAL TERMS

M1: Make 1 (inc) – Lift strand between needles to LH needle and work strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole, [knit or purl as indicated by pattern st].

2/2 LC Slip next 2 sts to cn and hold in front, k2, k2 from cn.

2/2 RC Slip next 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2, k2 from cn.

PATTERN STITCH

Cable Stitch (multiple of 10 sts)

Rows 1 and 3 (WS) K2, p6, k2.

Row 2 K2, 2/2 LC, k4.

Row 4 K4, 2/2 RC, k2.

Repeat Rows 1-4 for Cable Stitch.

NOTES: Pieces are knit back and forth in rows.

Circular needle is used to accommodate large number of stitches.

FRONT and **BACK** pieces are worked from center seam out to sides. Stitches are increased to form lower edge.

Finished pieces are folded in half and cast-on edges are sewn together for center seam.

BACK

Cast on 124 (144, 144, 144) sts.

Row 1 (WS) K1 for selvedge st, beg with Row 1, work 60 (70, 70, 70) sts in Cable st, p2, work 60 (70, 70, 70) sts in Cable st, k1 for selvedge st.

Inc Row 1 K1, work Row 2 of Cable st over 60 (70, 70, 70) sts for Left Back, M1, pm, k1, (pick up horizontal bar between next st and slip to LH needle, knit in front and back of picked-up st – 2-st inc made), pm, k1, M1, work 60 (70, 70, 70) sts in Cable st, k1 for Right Back – 128 (148, 148, 148) sts; 4 sts inc.

Work WS row as est, working new sts in Cable st.

Inc Row 2 Work in pat as est to first marker, M1, k1, M1, work Cable st to second marker, M1, k1, M1, work to end of row – 132 (152, 152, 152) sts 4 sts inc.

Work in pats as est, rep Inc Row 2 every other row, working new sts in Cable st, until piece measures 3 (3½, 3½, 4)" from beg, end with a WS row – 164 (192, 192, 200) sts.

Shape Neck

Cast on 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Working new sts in Cable st, rep Inc Row 2 every other row until piece measures 6 (6½, 7, 7½)" from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

Bind off 37 (39, 41, 46) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Working as est, dec 1 st at beg of next 6 rows.

Work until piece measures 9 (10, 11, 12)" from beg, end with a WS row. Bind off.

FRONT

Cast on 104 (124, 124, 124) sts.

Row 1 (WS) K1 for selvedge st, beg with Row 1, work 50 (60, 60, 60) sts in Cable st, p2, work 50 (60, 60, 60) sts in Cable st, k1 for selvedge st.

Inc Row 1 K1, work Row 2 of Cable st over 50 (60, 60, 60) sts, M1, pm, k1, (pick up horizontal bar between next st and slip to LH needle, knit in front and back of picked up st – 2-st inc made), pm, k1, M1, work 50 (60, 60, 60) sts in Cable st, k1 – 4 sts inc.

Work WS row as est, working new sts in Cable st.

Inc Row 2 Work in pat as est to first marker, M1, k1, M1, work Cable st to second marker, M1, k1, M1, work to end of row – 4 sts inc.

Work in pats as est, rep Inc Row 2 every other row, working new sts in Cable st until piece measures 3 (3½, 3½, 4)" from beg, end with a WS row – 144 (172, 172, 180) sts.

Shape Neck

Cast on 16 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Working new sts in Cable st, continue to work as for BACK. Bind off.

SLEEVE

Cast on 52 (62, 72, 82) sts.

Row 1 (WS) K1, beg with Row 1 work Cable st across to last st, k1.

Work in pats as est, inc 1 st every 6th row 5 times – 62 (72, 82, 92) sts.

Work until piece measures 5" from beg, end with a WS row.

Shape Cap

Bind off 3 (5, 8, 12) sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows – 52 (58, 62, 64) sts rem.

Dec 1 st at beg of every row 28 (34, 38, 40) times – 24 sts rem.

Bind off 3 sts at beg of next 4 rows – 12 sts rem.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements. Fold pieces in half along cast-on edge and sew together for center seam. Leave 1" of center seam at Neck edge of FRONT unsewn. Sew Shoulder seams. Sew in SLEEVES. Sew side and SLEEVE seams.



Weave in ends.
