EASY

SIZES Small (**Medium**, Large, **X-Large**)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Bust 36 (41½, 44, 49½)"/91.5 (105.5, 112, 125.5) cm

Length 17 (18, 19, 20)"/43 (45.5, 48.5, 51) cm

MATERIALS

- 6 (7, 7, 8) balls S. Charles Collezione **PASHA** 95% extrafine merino wool, 5% cashmere (1.75oz/50g; 98yds/90m) in **color #14 raspberry**
- One pair size 10 (6mm) needles
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Crochet hook size J-10 (6mm)
- Stitch holders
- One 1/2" snap
- 40 (45, 48, 53)" elastic cord
- Yarn needle

GAUGE

12 sts and 22 rows = 4"/10 cm in Stockinette stitch

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

PATTERN STITCHES

Stockinette stitch (St st) Knit all RS rows, purl all WS rows.

K2, p2 rib (multiple of 4 sts + 2)

Reverse single crochet

BACK

Cast on 54 (**62**, 66, **74**) sts; begin k2, p2 rib, end k2. Work even until piece measures 6" from beginning, end with a WS row.

(RS) Change to St st; work even until piece measures 9½ (**10**, 10½, **11**)" from beginning, end with a WS row.

Shape Armholes

(RS) Bind off 4 (**5**, 5, **6**) sts at beginning of next 2 rows, then decrease 1 st each side every other row 2 (**3**, 4, **4**) times – 42 (**46**, 48, **54**) stitches remain.

Work even until Armhole measures 7½ (**8**, 8½, **9**)" from beginning, end with a WS row.

Shape Shoulders and Neck

(RS) Work 13 (**15, 16, 19**) sts, bind off center 16 sts for BACK Neck, work to end. Place remaining 13 (**15, 16, 19**) sts on each side on holder for Shoulders.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 30 (**34, 38, 42**) sts; begin k2, p2 rib, end k2. Work even until piece measures 6" from beginning, end with a WS row.

(RS) Change to St st; work even until piece measures 8" from beginning, end with a WS row.

Shape Neck and Armhole

(RS) Decrease 1 st at Neck edge this row, every other row 8 (**7, 9, 8**) times, then every 4 rows 2 (**3, 3, 4**) times and **AT THE SAME TIME**, shape Armhole as for BACK – 13 (**15, 16, 19**) sts remain when all shaping is complete. Work even until Armhole measures same as for BACK. Place remaining sts on holder for shoulders.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for LEFT FRONT, reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES

Cast on 42 sts; begin k2, p2 rib, end k2. Work even until piece measures 6" from beginning, end with a WS row.

(RS) Change to St st; work even until piece measures 3", end with a WS row.

Shape Sleeve

(RS) Increase 1 st each side this row, then every 6th (**4th, 2nd, 2nd**) row 1 (**2, 3, 5**) times – 46 (**48, 52, 54**) sts. Work even until piece measures 10" from beginning, end with a WS row.

Shape Cap

(RS) Bind off 4 (**5, 5, 6**) sts at beginning of next 2 rows, decrease 1 st each side every other row 7 (**7, 9, 9**) times, then bind off 2 sts at beginning of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining 16 sts.

COLLAR

Cast on 98 (**104, 110, 116**) sts; begin p2, k2 rib, end p2. Work even for 3 rows.

Shape Collar

(RS) Decrease 1 st each side this row, then every 4th row 5 times – 86 (**92, 98, 104**) sts remain. Work even until piece measures 5½" from beginning, end with a WS row.

FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements. Join shoulders using Three-Needle Bind-Off. Set in SLEEVES; sew side and SLEEVE seams. With RS of COLLAR and WS of garment facing, sew bound-off edge of COLLAR to Neck shaping, being careful not to let seam show on WS of garment. Weave in ends.

Left Front Edging

With RS facing, using crochet hook, join yarn at lower left edge, chain 1, working from left to right, reverse single crochet evenly along FRONT edge to top edge of COLLAR. Fasten off.

Right Front Edging

Work as for Left Front Edging, beginning at top edge of COLLAR.

Sew one half of snap to RS of Left FRONT, just in from front edge, ¾" above end of ribbing; sew remaining half opposite first half. Thread elastic cord through top row of ribbing, being careful not to let cord show on RS. Tie bow in one end of cord. Adjust fit; tie bow in opposite end of cord.

ABBREVIATIONS

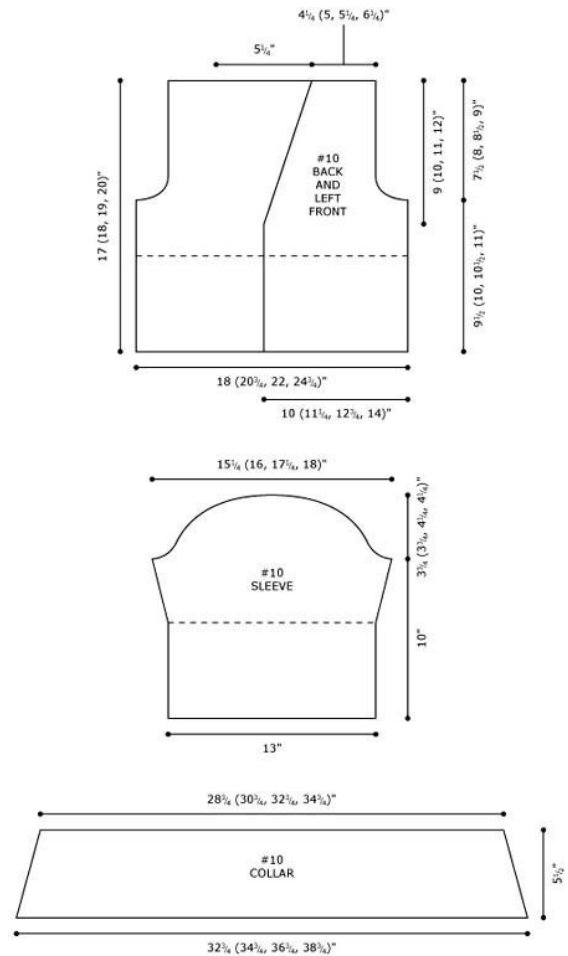
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together
p	purl
RS	right side
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side

SPECIAL TERMS

3-NEEDLE BIND OFF:

(Seaming 2 pieces together as you bind off)

Place sts of pieces to be joined on separate needles or on each end of a circular needle. Hold one behind the other with RS's facing each other in left hand. With a third needle of the same size (or 1 size larger than that used to knit the pieces), k2tog [1 from front needle, 1 from back needle – 1 st on right-hand needle], * k2tog [2 sts on right-hand needle], bind off 1 st in usual manner; repeat from * to end. For a decorative seam on RS, work as above with WS's facing.



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
