



**Tweed Beret Trio**  
designed by Linda Cyr

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**  
10 ½" in diameter

**MATERIALS**

- Tahki Yarns Dream, 1 ball each as follows –
  - 1) Denim - #020 slate blue (A), #002 off white (B), #011 off black (C)
  - 2) Vintage - #020 slate blue (A), #019 light olive (B), #023 dark chocolate (C)
  - 3) Autumn – #016 tan (A), #018 pumpkin (B), #023 dark chocolate (C)
- Size 9 (5.5 mm) knitting needles, or size to obtain gauge
- Size 9 (5.5mm) circular needle 16"/40cm) long
- Yarn needle



**GAUGE**

16 sts and 30 rows = 4" in Garter St.  
TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE.

**Note** 2 strands of each color are held together throughout – for a total of 6 strands

**BERET**

With one strand each A, B, C as noted above, cast on 18 sts.

**Row 1** Slip 1 with yarn in front, knit 17.

**Row 2 and all wrong-side rows** Slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front, knit to end.

**Row 3** Slip 1 with yarn in front, k15, turn.

**Row 5** Slip 1 with yarn in front, k13, turn.

Continue in this manner, work 2 less sts each odd row until last even row has 2 stitches – wedge completed.

**(WS)** Slip 1 with yarn in front, k1.

Repeat from Row 1 until 12 wedges completed. Bind off all sts.

Sew bind-off edge to cast-on edge, draw up sts at center.

Pick up 108 sts around perimeter of circle. Begin working circularly.

**Rows 1 – 3** Knit.

**Row 4** [K7, k2tog] around.

**Rows 5 – 7** Knit.

**Row 8** [K6, k2tog] around.

**Rows 9 – 10** Knit.

**Row 11** [P5, p2tog] around.

**Row 12** Knit.

**Row 13** Purl.

Bind off all sts.

**FINISHING**

Weave in ends. Steam block beret over a 10 ½" in diameter dinner plate.
