EASY

SIZES

Small (**Medium**, Large, **X-Large**)

KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Bust 34 (**38**, 42, **46**)/86.5 (**96.5**, 106.5, **117**) cm

Length 31 (**32**, 33, **34**)/78.5 (**81.5**, 84, **86.5**) cm

MATERIALS

- 8 (**9**, 10, **11**) balls Filatura Di Crosa **ZARA CHINÉ** 100% extrafine merino wool (1.75oz/50g; 137yds/125m) in **color #1653 charcoal chiné**
- One pair size 6 (4mm) needles
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

GAUGE

20 sts and 26 rows = 4"/10 cm in Stockinette stitch

TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

PATTERN STITCHES

Garter stitch Knit every row.

Stockinette stitch (St st) Knit all RS rows, purl all WS rows.

K2, p2 rib (multiple of 4 sts)

BACK

Cast on 116 (**126**, 136, **146**) sts.

(RS) Begin Garter st; work 4 rows.

(RS) Change to St st; decrease 1 st at each side every 8 rows 15 times – 86 (**96**, 106, **116**) sts remain.

Work even until piece measures 19" from beginning, end with a WS row.

(RS) Continue in St st, working first and last 24 sts in k2, p2 rib; work 4 rows.

Shape Armholes

(RS) Bind off 8 (**10**, 12, **14**) sts at beginning of next 2 rows – 70 (**76**, 82, **88**) sts remain.

(RS) Continue in St st, keeping first and last 16 (**14**, 12, **10**) sts in k2, p2 rib. Work even until Armhole measures 9 (**10**, 11, **12**)" from beginning, end with a WS row.

(RS) Change to k2, p2 rib; work 4 rows.

Place a marker each side of center 34 (38, 42, 46) sts.

Shape Neck

(RS) Work across to marker, join a second ball of yarn and bind off center sts, work to end – 18 (19, 20, 21) sts remain each shoulder.

Working both sides at the same time, work even in k2, p2 rib until Armhole measures 11½ (12½, 13½, 14½)". Bind off all sts in rib.

FRONT

Work as for BACK until Armhole measures 6 (7, 8, 9)" from beginning, end with a WS row.

(RS) Change to k2, p2 rib; work 4 rows.

Place a marker each side of center 34 (38, 42, 46) sts.

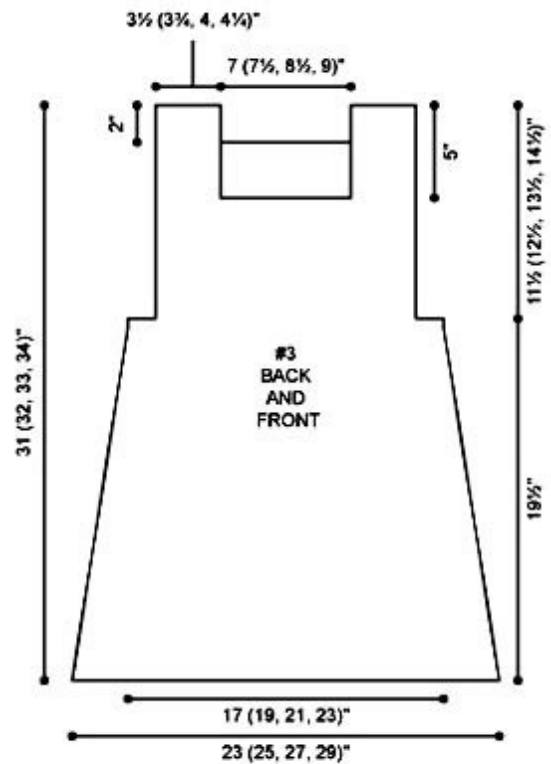
Shape Neck

(RS) Work across to marker, join a second ball of yarn and bind off center sts, work to end – 18 (19, 20, 21) sts remain each Shoulder.

Working both sides at the same time, work even in k2, p2 rib until Armhole measures 11½ (12½, 13½, 14½)". Bind off all sts in rib.

FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements. Sew shoulder and side seams. Weave in ends.
