



## MERINO CABLÉ LOOP SCARF

designed by Irina Poludnenko



INTERMEDIATE

### KNITTED MEASUREMENTS

Scarf measures 7" wide by 60" long

### MATERIALS

- 7 – 1.75oz/50g balls (83yds/75m) S. Charles Collezione MERINO CABLÉ 100% extrafine Merino wool in color #120 red
  - One pair size 8 (5mm) needles
- OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE**
- Yarn needle

### GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows = 4"/10 cm in Loop Stitch

### TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE

### SPECIAL TECHNIQUE

**Make A Loop: (RS)** Knit next st, but do not drop st from left-hand needle, yarn forward, wrap yarn around thumb of left hand, yarn back, knit same st through the back, drop st from left-hand needle, pass second st on right-hand needle over first st, pull loop to tighten.

### PATTERN STITCHES

Seed stitch (Seed st)

### Loop Stitch (multiple of 4 sts + edge sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** \* Work 3 sts in Seed st, make a loop; repeat from \* across to last 3 sts, work in Seed st to end.

**Row 2:** Work even in Seed st.

**Row 3:** Work 1 st in Seed st, \* make a loop, work 3 sts in Seed st; repeat from \* across to last 2 sts, make a loop, work last st in Seed st.

**Row 4:** Work even in Seed st. Repeat Rows 1–4 for Loop st.

### SCARF

Cast on 27 sts.

**(RS)** Begin Seed st, p1; work even for 2 rows, end with a wrong-side row.

**(RS)** Begin Loop st; work even until piece measures 60" from beg, end with a right-side row.

Work even for 2 rows in Seed st.

Bind off all sts loosely in pattern.

### FINISHING

Using yarn needle, weave in all ends.
